As we approach summer's end we start to think about curling. We continue to send Applications by E-mail, as this reaches over 90% of our membership, and importantly is very cost effective. Of course, those of you not on E-mail will continue to receive your Application by regular mail. Please note the **Application** itself is in a separate document, as well as the required **Participants Agreement (which only needs to be signed if you were not a member last year)**, please send in one copy of each per applicant and ensure you sign these forms. If you do not have access to a printer or are unable to print these forms, just contact me and I will get them to you.

Please note: YOUTH PROGRAM APPLICATIONS and Participants Agreement (**again only to be signed if not a member last year**), will be sent with a separate covering letter.

We have also included a line for your E-mail address. This address will NOT be printed in the Roster. It will, however, ensure that you receive all the latest information from our club in a timely manner through our regular Newsletter and updates. For those of you without E-mail access, you will receive these by regular mail.

The curling fees for the 2015-2016 season are as follows: (**Including H.S.T & OCA fees**)

Full Membership: \$395 including the capital assessment of \$25 this entitles you to curl as often as you would like during the season.

Full Membership – New Member Special: If you have never curled at Bobcaygeon Curling Club the fees are \$299 including the capital assessment of \$25. This likewise entitles you to curl as often as you like during the season.

Once a Week Only Special: \$275 including the capital assessment of \$25. This entitles you to curl only on your specified day

Little Rocker and Junior Memberships grouped as the Youth Program:
\$60

Non-Curling Social Membership: \$60

Lockers: \$30 (full locker); \$15 (shared)

Post-dated cheques are acceptable provided dated no later than
September 30, 2015.

Senior Men

Thursday, October 15 at 10.00 a.m. is the date for our Senior Men's Opening Meeting.

The following will be addressed.

Opening greeting; Introduction of new members; discussion of weekly schedule; discussion on Bonspiel dates and play; discussion on draw master rules; discussion on year-end play down format.

When completing your Application should you wish to take advantage of car-pooling please make the appropriate notation so that we can look after this request when scheduling your curling time.

This is **Tag** curling which simply means that although you choose which day you wish to curl there is no commitment, as teams are put together by the draw master on the day. Should you be unable to curl you do NOT have to find a spare.

Importantly, if you are unavailable to curl on your chosen day, you might still wish to show up on another day, and subject to that day's attendance you probably will be able to curl, realizing that the registered curlers have priority. Armand Hachey – Convener 705-243-9573.

Kawartha Senior Men's Curling League

The Bobcaygeon Curling Club is a member of KSMCL. The League was founded in 1981 by Peterborough Golf and CC and Campbellford CC. The League is comprised of 10 clubs stretching from Bobcaygeon in the north to Cobourg in the south and Campbellford in the east.

The number of team entries per club varies, and our club has been one of the main contributors with 9 teams at one point, last year we had 6 teams. The purpose of the league is to have competition and social interaction with other clubs. Points are awarded for league play and a trophy awarded to the club with the most points at year end. Each team will play 5 – 8 games during the season, usually at 1.30 or 2.00 p.m. one game per day. We send three teams to each club for the scheduled league play. In addition to the league play each club hosts a 2-game bonspiel. Each of our teams will play in 3 or 4 bonspiels. Bonspiel cost is \$30 per player, which includes lunch. Players take turn driving and passengers pay \$5 to help with gas costs. The KL committee will try to balance the teams with a mix of new and experienced curlers.

IN ORDER TO BE COMPETITIVE IN BONSPIELS THE KL COMMITTEE WILL CONSIDER SELECTING BONSPIEL TEAMS FOR SOME EVENTS.

Participating in the Kawartha League is an excellent way to meet other

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curlers and improve your skills. Bernie Forbert, one of our long term KL participants says

“It is always great to meet and greet familiar faces at other clubs and test your skills on other ices”. It is necessary, for planning purposes, that we know the number of KL curlers early in the season. CAYGEON FALLS MEN'S CURLING LEAGUE

This will be the second season for this Senior Men's League, co-hosted by the Fenelon Falls Curling Club and Bobcaygeon Curling Club. Last season we had 4 teams from each club and it is probable that this scenario will again occur this year. If there is a demand for more teams, then a second draw will have to be scheduled.

The proposed schedule will see those games played at Fenelon Falls to be at 9.30 a.m. on Mondays, the games hosted by our club, due to commitments to the Kawartha League, will be played at 1.30 p.m. on Wednesday afternoons. The schedule calls for 16 games followed by play-offs and a closing lunch.

Entries are limited to teams only, with the entry fee (over and above our regular membership fee) being \$50 per man or \$200 per team. Fenelon Falls teams must be comprised entirely of players registered with their club, and likewise Bobcaygeon teams must also be comprised of players registered with our club.

The proceeds from the entry fees are split equally between the 2 clubs, after an agreed amount is deducted to cover the closing lunch, which the current schedule calls to be hosted by Bobcaygeon.

BONSPIEL COMMITTEE

The curling season will soon become the focus of our social life for the next 6 months. As in past years, the Bobcaygeon Curling Club will host a number of bonspiels, some restricted to club members, and others are hosted with a view to inviting out of town curlers to come to Bobcaygeon to enjoy our facilities, our hospitality and the shopping of our town.

The profits made on these invitational bonspiels are used to keep our membership fees in check, by contributing to the overall revenue of our curling club.

For Invitational Bonspiels the price will remain the same as last year, namely \$180 all taxes included. This price includes lunch and dinner for the team.

A short note regarding each bonspiel will be found in the Book of Bonspiels located in the cubbyhole adjacent to the kitchen entry

The ladies division will post their entry requirements in the Ladies Lounge for their bonspiels. Entry to the Invitational Bonspiels is by a lottery from all those teams who have indicated an interest to participate.

For all the Invitational Bonspiels (Ladies, Men's and Mixed) the Board of Directors has confirmed that club members will be expected to forward a post-dated cheque with the completed Application to the bonspiel chairperson, at the time of registration, for such registration to be valid.

For Mixed and Men's Invitational Bonspiels the first two Bobcaygeon teams per draw will be confirmed entry.

Further teams are invited to register as additional teams may be needed to fill each bonspiel, in the event that the number of out of town participants does not fill the bonspiel.

The Board of Directors has confirmed that to be considered a "Bobcaygeon Team" that team must have at least 2 club members on the roster for that bonspiel, and further, that to be considered an "out of town" rink they must have no more than 2 Bobcaygeon club members on the roster.

For in-club bonspiels, i.e. not "Invitational", the individual bonspiel conveners will be posting notices, sign-up sheets and bonspiel dates on individual notice boards, located in the lower hall. NAME BADGES

There will be a sign-up sheet on the bulletin board in the lounge area on the first day of the posted practice week, to be taken down two weeks after the season starts for ordering. Please note we only order once a year.

BROOMS

The brooms located on the wall on the curling surface are for use during Practice/Instruction sessions, and Junior and Little Rocker programs ONLY. These brooms are not to be used for members' regular play, and we ask therefore that every member should possess their own broom.

NOTE: Hair brooms are not allowed for sweeping during regular games within our club.
